Chain necklaces are very popular this year. This class will teach you a basic spiral s-chain link that you can combine to make a chain of any length.

Skills Required:

Intro to Wire Wrap Class 1 or

Know how to make spirals, basic loops and wrapped loops, open and close jump rings

Materials:

Half-hard round wire, 20 or 18 gauge. You can use BeadSmith silver-coated copper wire or copper wire to perfect your skills. It looks good and is about \$3 a package. Available at Bead Stores.

Commercial Clasp or S Clasp

Optional 4mm beads or crystal bicones or rounds. Use 20 ga wire if you want to add crystals.

Tools:

Round nose pliers

Flat nose pliers

Chain nose pliers or 2nd pair of flat nose pliers

Wire cutters

Sharpie

Ruler
